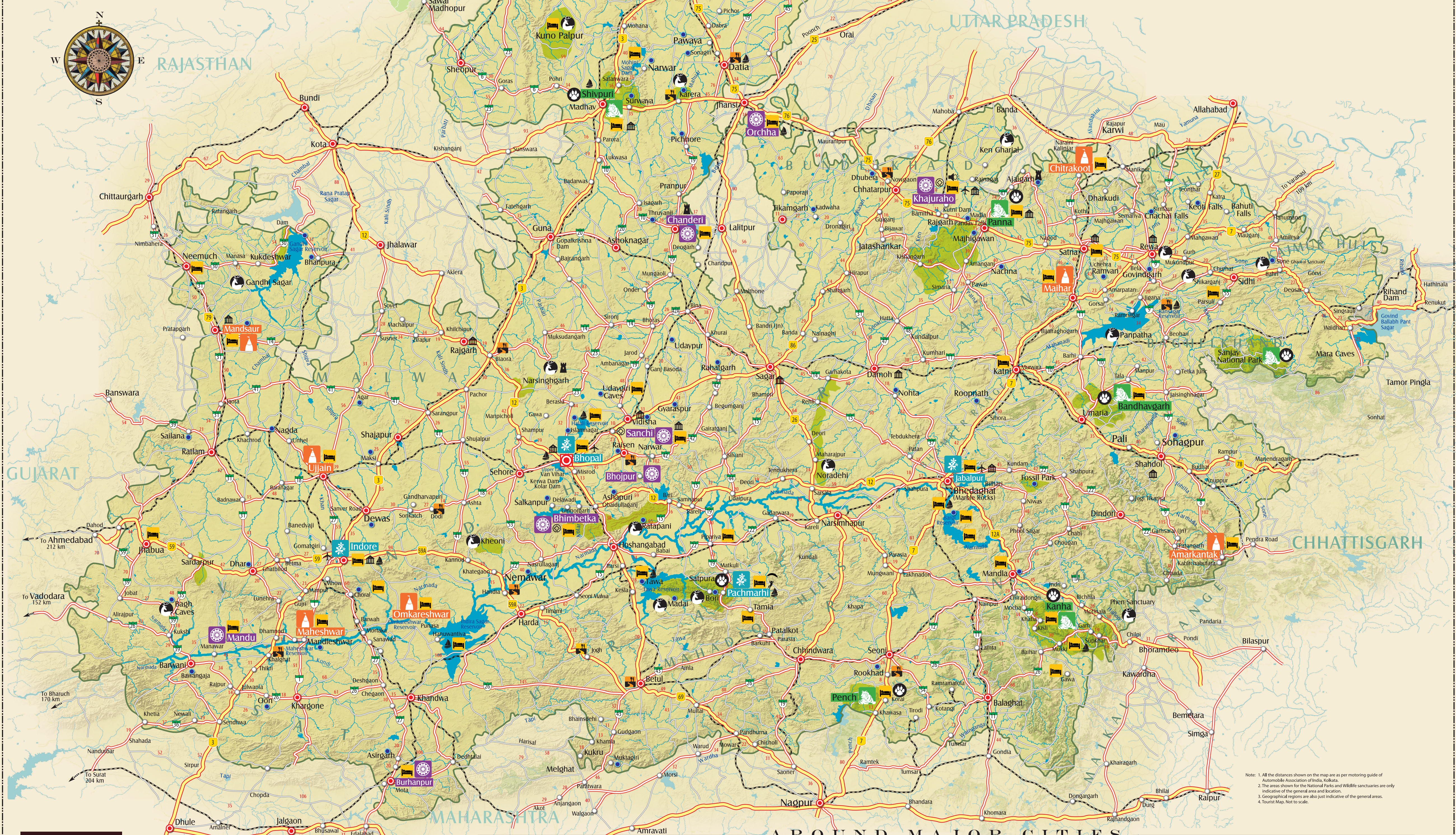

- Indore:** Choral Dam 40 km, Mandu 100 km, Maheshwar 90 km, Burhanpur 187 km, Hanuwantya 165 km, Omkareshwar 87 km.
- Jabalpur:** Jabalpur 25 km, Bargi 40 km, Amarkantak 230 km, Kanha 190 km, Pench 195 km, Bandhavgarh 210 km.
- Khajuraho:** Orchha 172 km, Ajaiagarh 76 km, Chitrakoot 150 km, Panna 30 km, Mukundpur Wildlife Sanctuary 210 km, Sanjay National Park 280 km, Maihar 132 km.
- Pachmarhi:** Madhai 50 km, Pachmarhi 45 km, Tania 45 km, Patalkot 55 km, Pench 240 km.
